

CONDITIONS OF USE:

(1) The photographs may only be used or distributed with the attachment of the copyright ownership © *Gerald Zugmann / www.zugmann.com* – either directly with the illustration, or at least clearly attributed.

For use on the internet, the copyright ownership must be indicated by means of a link to www.zugmann.com.

Failure to display copyright ownership will result in a surcharge of 100 % of the agreed picture fee.

(2) After going to press a sample copy must be sent.

(3) Agreed fees are due within 14 days of the invoice date. Arrears interest will be charged thereafter.

(4) Permission to use is considered to be given only upon payment of the invoice.

(5) The dispatch of duplicates / prints / data is deemed to be on loan. All material provided remains the property of *Gerald Zugmann Fotografie KEG*.

The image material transmitted (analogue or digitally) may only be used to the extent agreed and for the agreed purposes only. Electronic storage is allowed only for the duration of processing in the context of the agreed usage. No permanent storage in electronic archives, databases, on CD-ROM or similar data media, or in analogue form (enlargement, print out, slide duplicate, etc.) is allowed. Digital picture data must be deleted from all of the user's computers and data media after the agreed usage rights have been exercised.

(6) Any changes (except colour adjustment and refocusing) or redesign of the photographs require the written consent of *Gerald Zugmann Fotografie KEG*.

(7) In the absence of unauthorised use or unauthorised further use of the photographs, the licensee owes us compensation comprising a minimum of 5 times the license fee that we would usually demand for further use. This applies in particular also when the license deadline or the licensed number of copies is exceeded without prior written consent from us with regard to the extension of the license.

(8) Our conditions are deemed to be accepted at the latest upon use of the photographs.

Place of fulfilment and jurisdiction is Vienna. Austrian law applies.
